

**Advisory Bulletin for 2009 St. Mathew Blue King Crab Reporting in the
Economic Data Report (EDR) – May 6, 2010**



This advisory bulletin is being provided to BSAI CR Fishery EDR submitters who had St. Mathew Blue (SMB) King Crab landings in calendar year 2009. The purpose of this bulletin is to provide guidance on providing SMB data in your EDR submission as space was not made available for that fishery in the EDR booklets before printing.

SMB	St. Mathew blue king crab (<i>Paralithodes platypus</i>)	in waters of the EEZ with a northern boundary of 62° N. lat., a southern boundary of 58°30' N. lat., and a western boundary of the maritime Boundary Agreement Line as that line is described in the text of and depicted in the annex to the Maritime Boundary Agreement between the United States and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics signed in Washington, June 1, 1990, and as the Maritime Boundary Agreement Line as depicted on NOAA Chart No. 513 (6 th edition, February 23, 1991) and NOAA Chart No. 514 (6 th edition, February 16, 1991).
