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2006 Northern California Dungeness Crab Quality Test – 3rd Interim Report

The protocol that governs the test of Dungeness crab quality in northern California sets a minimum recovery goal of 25% rounded to the nearest whole integer.

As of this writing a second Ft Bragg test has not been completed.

During the second test for Crescent City, Eureka and Trinidad, November 8-10, 2006, a total of 3,174 pounds of crab (green weight) were landed for the crab quality test from 7 different locations. These crab yielded a 811 pounds of meat recovered for a combined recovery rate of 25.6%. The crab meat will be provided to various non-profit and Senior Citizen groups.

The recovery percentages for this test by port were:
