INDUSTRY NOTICE TO COASTAL COMMERCIAL DUNGENESS CRAB FISHERS AND PROCESSORS

July 28, 2009

The area outside 4-miles will CLOSE effective 8:00 a.m. August 1, 2009.

The Coastal Dungeness Crab Summer Fishery Management Plan is now in effect:

The Summer Fishery Management Plan is designed to give WDFW staff the information needed to allow the commercial Dungeness crab fishery to continue during the summer and to provide fishers with some predictability on the implementation of specific management measures to protect soft-shelled crab. The Summer Fishery Management Plan includes the closure of the waters west of 4-miles beginning on July 1. This year, shell condition sampling indicated that there were large enough numbers of hard-shelled male crab to delay the closure of the area outside 4-miles through July 31, 2009. However, because the most recent sampling results and reports from fishers indicate the percentages of soft crab are on the rise WDFW is putting into effect the closure of Dungeness crab fishing in the area outside 4-miles – effective 8:00 a.m. August 1, 2009.

In addition, if we continue to see an increase in soft-shelled crab in our at-sea sampling inside 4-miles, or if significant numbers of soft crab continue to be landed - we will take additional management measures.

The 4-mile line is defined as those waters west of straight lines drawn in sequence from south to north between the following coordinates:
