WASHINGTON COASTAL DUNGENESS CRAB INDUSTRY NOTICE

February 24, 2016

SPECIAL MANAGEMENT AREA CHANGE:

The purpose of this notice is to inform you of changes to the Quinault Special Management Area (SMA). According to the terms of the 2015-2016 State-Quinault Dungeness Crab Harvest Management Plan (Harvest Management Plan), the Primary SMA will revert to the Secondary SMA at 8:00 am February 29, 2016. This change will open the area from Raft River to Split Rock to state fishers.

Quinault:

A Quinault **secondary SMA** (SSMA) will be established at 8:00 a.m. on February 29, 2016. The area that remains closed to state fishers includes the area shoreward of a line approximating the 27-fathom depth curve between the mouth of the Copalis River (47°08.00) and Split Rock (47°24.50) according to the following coordinates:

•	Northeast Corner (Split Rock):	47°24.50' N. Lat.	124°20.00' W. Lon.
•	Northwest Corner:	47°24.50' N. Lat.	124°32.40' W. Lon.
٠	Southwest Corner:	47°08.00' N. Lat.	124°25.50' W. Lon.
•	Southeast Corner (Copalis River	:): 47°08.00' N. Lat.	124°11.20' W. Lon.

There is a 200-pot limit in the area that opens to state fishers between Split Rock (47°24.50) and Raft River (47°28.00) shoreward of a line approximating the 27-fathom depth curve from 8:00 a.m. on February 29, 2016, through 8:00 a.m. March 31, 2014. Fishers must pre-register with WDFW prior to deploying gear in this area by one of the three following methods:

<u>Makah:</u>

We want to remind you that the Makah SMA, in the area between Destruction Island and the US Canada Border, is open (as of February 16, 2016.)



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There is a 200-pot limit in this area until 8:00 A.M. March 17, 2016 (the first 30-days following the opening of this SMA). Fishers must pre-register with WDFW **twenty-four hours** prior to deploying gear in this area. Fishers can pre-register by one of the three following methods:

The Makah SMA is described as the coastal waters between $48^{0}02.15$ N' Lat. to $48^{0}19.50$ N' Lat. east of a line connecting those points approximating the 25-fathom line according to the following coordinates:

٠	Northeast Corner:	Tatoosh Island	
٠	Northwest Corner:	48 ⁰ 19.50' N. Lat.	124 ⁰ 50.45' W. Lon.
٠	Southwest Corner:	48°02.15' N. Lat.	124°50.45' W. Lon.

Southwest Corner: 48^o02.15' N. Lat. 124^o50.45' W. Lon.
Southeast Corner: 48^o02.15' N. Lat. 124^o41.00' W. Lon.

Quileute:

The Quileute SMA remains closed to state fishers. The Quileute SMA is described as the area from Cape Johnson to Destruction Island shoreward of a line approximating 30 fathoms according to the following points:

٠	Northeast Corner (Cape Johnson):	47°58.00' N. Lat.	124 ⁰ 40.40' W. Lon.
٠	Northwest Corner:	47°58.00' N. Lat.	124°49.00' W. Lon.
٠	Southwest Corner:	47°40.50' N. Lat.	124°40.00' W. Lon.
٠	Southeast Corner: (Destruction Isla	nd): 47°40.50' N. Lat.	124 ⁰ 24.43' W. Lon.
