The following information is being circulated as a courtesy to the
California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The following changes are being made to the proposed regulatory text of §132.6 to address the CA Dungeness Crab Task Force recommendation submitted to the Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) during the initial 45-day public comment period and concerns related to the measurement of the surface line:

- Subsection (a)(1), limit the addition of trailer buoys from the main buoy to “No more than two trailer buoys” regardless of depth.
- Subsection (c), specify that the maximum length of line is to be measured “between the front end of the main buoy to the tail end of the last trailer buoy.”
