2014 Mid-Term Elections

Competitive Senate Races

Republicans looking to claim their first Senate majority in eight years will need to pick up three Democratic-held seats in addition to the three in Montana, South Dakota and West Virginia where they already have an edge. The most likely targets are toss-up races in Arkansas and Louisiana, and contested seats in Alaska, Iowa, New Hampshire and North Carolina. (from Roll Call, 8/14)

Magnuson-Stevens Act (MSA)

- RFMC CCC publishes final reauthorization recommendations (7/14)
- NOAA NSG1 PR expected late 2014/early 2015
- Data Confidentiality FR pending (77 FR 30486)
- NOAA rescinds "NEPA Consistency" PR (79 FR 40703; 7/14)
- NOAA creating a "National Prioritization of Fish Stock Assessments" (started 2/14)
- NOAA Regional Science Center peer reviews continue; (http://www.st.nmfs.noaa.gov/science-program-review/index)

MSA Activities: House

- Natural Resources Full Committee Reauthorization Hearing on "Discussion Draft"; (2/14; ROMEA's Rick Marks testifies, Draft becomes H.R. 4742)
- Full Committee Mark-up of H.R. 4742 "Strengthening Fishing Communities and Increasing Flexibility in Fisheries Management Act" (5/14)
- OUTLOOK: Passage by full House possible this year...

MSA Activities: Senate

- Senate Commerce Subcommittee (Sens. Begich/Rubio) introduce "Discussion Draft"; viewed as controversial (4/14); includes Dungeness Crab sunset provision
- Staff revises "Staff Working Draft" for comment (7/14); 2nd draft drops EBM, forage fish, and bycatch provisions; far less controversial
- outlook: Staff will review comments & introduce a formal bill this year; committee mark-up possible; passage this year unlikely; we start from here in 2015...***Chairman Doc Hastings (WA-R-4th) retiring 2014

National Ocean Policy Update

- <u>Defeated</u>: Senate 2015 WRDA provision creating a "National Endowment for the Oceans" funding NOP
- <u>Approved</u>: House FY15 WRDA & Interior appropriations provisions prohibiting use of federal funds to implement NOP
- Substantial funding from NGOs supports NOP Regional Planning Body (RPB) Process; RPBs continue to develop to varying degrees
- NE & MID RPB's to finalize regional plans by 2016
- Pac NW & GOMEX slower; WA developing CMSP; Pac NW Tribal RPB webinar (7/14); regional efforts continue depending on \$\$\$

Marine Sanctuaries & Monuments

- NOAA/NOS amends NMSA regulations adding new site public petition process (79 FR 33851; 6/14)
- NOAA creates Sanctuary "Business Advisory Council" (1/14)
- NOAA issues Marine Monument Grant Program (3/14)
- H.R. 4942 provision specifies MSA as the controlling statute in cases of conflict (i.e. MSA v. NMSA)
- Administration executive authority expands CA Coastal Nat'l
 Monument to include Point Arera-Storrietta Public Lands (4/14)
- Administration executive authority to create the world's largest marine monument (780,000 km) in the Pacific Remote Islands (6/14)
- H.R.1459/H.R.4742/H.R.4988/H.R.5389/S.2608 contain elements to limit Administrative executive authority; require Congressional approval

Climate Change #1

- U.S. State Department convenes international conference Oceans Under Threat: Charting a Sustainable Future";
 Washington, D.C., June 16-18, 2014
- Participants announce \$1.8B in partnerships to protect more than 3 million km of ocean; Leonardo DeCaprio pledges \$7M to help ban "bottom trolling"
- Other focus areas: marine protected areas, sustainable fisheries, reducing marine pollution, preventing and monitoring ocean acidification, building capacity, supporting coastal communities, and ocean mapping

Climate Change #2

- White House creates a National Climate Change Task Force (11/13) incl. CA/WA Governors & leaders of 5 West Coast/Alaska communities
- NOAA study suggests corals can adapt to moderate climate change (10/13)
- NOAA study suggests large fraction of West Coast pteropod population negatively affected by acidification (5/14)
- CA launches 10 North Coast Marine Protected Area Monitoring Grants (12/13)

Protected Species #1

- CA Sea Lion: (H.R. 1308; Rep. Doc Hastings) "Endangered Salmon & Fisheries Predation Prevention Act") passes full Committee (1/14); NOAA wins HSUS court challenge (10/13), State removal permits remain effective to 5/2016
- NOAA holds pod cast on status of So. Res. Killer Whales (1/14); 10-yr status report (6/14), no recovery/no solutions; NGO petitions NOAA to increase Critical Habitat from Cape Flattery, WA to Point Reyes, CA out to 47 miles (4/14), decision pending...
- NOAA extends comment period to delist Central North Pacific Humpback Whale DPS to 8/27 (79 FR 40054)
- NGOs sue NOAA to expand Right Whale Critical Habitat and reduce vessel speeds (impacts only East Coast, for now...)

Protected Species #2

- Final Rule: SSL *Eastern DPS* delisted (79 FR 66140; 11/13)
- SSL Western DPS: NOAA revises BiOp, certain fisheries no longer causing jeopardy (4/14)
- Migratory gray whale numbers increasing: NOAA survey results in 2010=38 animals; 2012=182; 2013=364
- NOAA testing drones for wildlife surveys (7/14)
- NGOs sue Feds to ban seafood imports from countries that do not protect marine mammals to U.S. MMPA standards (7/14)

SHARK #1

- Shark stocks managed by NOAA for legal harvest; practice of "finning" illegal since 2000;
 Shark Conservation Act 2010 adds protection
- CA/WA/OR/MD/DE/NY/MA/IL/HI adopt laws banning all fin possession which are inconsistent with federal law (NOAA allows for sharks to be landed legally w/fins attached to the carcass)
- NOAA issues PR declaring State laws prohibiting fin possession are not preempted by federal law (2/14)

SHARK #2

- CA DFW status report on NE population of great white shark concludes not Threatened or Endangered (4/14); final decision pending...(NOAA previously rejected 2 NGO listing petitions)
- NOAA accepts petition to ESA list 9 shark species; status determinations ongoing (78 FR 69376)
- Hilton Hotels bows to public pressure, bans shark fin soup from all its restaurants (4/14)

ESA #1

- House ESA Working Group to seek improvements (ESA last reauthorized 1988)
- Working Group Report "Findings and Recommendations" (2/14; See http://esaworkinggroup.hastings.house.gov)
- July 2014, House passes (H.R.4315; 4316; 4317 & 4318 as H.R. 4315 "21st Century Endangered Species Transparency Act") to improve transparency, use of best available scientific information, and curtail the expenses of litigation (no similar Senate activity expected this Congress)
- Reform bills were vigorously opposed by numerous national environmental groups

ESA #2

- USFWS proposes to amend policy on landowner credits for protecting at-risk wildlife. Comments due 9/22/14;
 (www.fws.gov/endangered/improving_ESA/prelisting-conservation.html)
- Pending FR: USFWS/NOAA amends Sec.7 regulations for incidental take statements and use of surrogates to estimate takes (78 FR 54437)
- FR: USFWS/NOAA change policy re: what is a "significant portion of the range" (7/14); Agencies promptly sued by CBD in the 9th Circuit; decision pending...

ESA #3

- NOAA issues Critical Habitat (CH) designation for loggerheads; no CH in Pacific (6/14)
- NGOs sue NOAA;
 agency closes Pacific
 Loggerhead
 Conservation Area to
 drift swordfish gillnet
 fishing (7/13)

ESA Petition to list captive killer whale
 "Lolita" approved by NOAA (1/14)

 NOAA reviewing ESA petition to list 3 hagfish and 3 sea snakes (78 FR 66675)

Catch Share Update #1

- NOAA Report: Design/Use of Fishing Communities and Regional Fishery Associations in IFQ's (1/14)
- Review of NOAA Catch Share Programs (5/14; Rept. No. OIG-14-019-1)
- H.R.2646/S.1275: "Revitalizing the Economy of Fisheries in the Pacific Act" or "REFI Act" to refinance 2003 West Coast Groundfish buyback loans; awaiting action...
- GOMEX Sector Separation-Allocation-Litigation-State
 Jurisdictional issues complicate IFQ mgmt

Catch Share Update #2

- 24-Member House letter supporting zero FY15 funding for new IFQs in NE/MID/SA/GOMEX
- FY15: Amendment to FY15 House CJS to prohibit development of new catch share programs in these regions fails on close vote

EPA NPDES Vessel Discharge Permit Update

- EPA issues FINAL "VGP" requirements for commercial vessels (incl. commercial fishing/charter boats) > 79 ft for incidental/ballast discharges; effective 12/19/14
- Final "sVGP" permit regulations for all remaining vessels < 79 ft expected fall 2014; also effective 12/19/14</p>
- House moves USCG bill to include permanent fix; Senate Commerce Committee moves companion legislation (S.2094) amid open opposition from CA & WA
- Several States/Administration oppose fix (RE: ballast provisions/state jurisdiction; Admin also opposes incidental discharge fix); negotiations ongoing...

Aquatic Invasive Species

- H.R.1823/S.2530 to add
 Quagga Mussels to the
 Lacey Act; S.2530 contains
 important Lacey Act
 exemption)
- OR/WA AIS Rapid
 Response Working Group
 meeting (12/13)
- Congress passes WRDA 2015 w/out strong AIS authorizing provisions (5/14)

- H.R. 3994 (Rep. Bishop, R-UT-1) protects federal lands from AIS (2/14); hearing (7/14)
- FY15 Senate Interior:
 USFWS AIS +\$5M over
 FY14; no mention of
 zebra/quagga
- FY15 House Interior:
 USFWS \$3M + NPS \$2M
 for zebra/quagga with
 strong report language

Tribal Issues of Interest

- DOI issues \$10M grant program supporting climate change preparedness (7/14)
- Sen. Tester (MT-D)
 replaces Sen. Cantwell as
 chair of Senate Indian
 Affairs Committee
- Washington, DC NFL franchise loses trademark but could retain team name; litigation ongoing...

- Quinault (WA) receive \$1.5M Commerce grant to upgrade Queets fisheries facility
- CA creates official state holiday on June 24th; Native American Day
- Mr. Billy Frank Jr. of the Nisqually Nation Walks On May 5th
- Mr. Chester Nez, our last Navajo Code Talker Walks On June 4th

- House/Senate USCG reform underway; "outof-water" survival craft issue in flux...

- Administration EO on IUU Fishing/Seafood Fraud (6/14); Nat'l task force & round of August public meetings & 30-day comment period, all after legislation stalls;

- NOAA approves fishery disaster for Frazier River Sockeye Fishery (1/14)
- NOAA awards \$21M to AK Chinook Salmon fishery disaster (3/13)

- PEPA gets split decision from Supreme Court on power plant emissions (6/14); Public meetings continue on the EPA's controversial rule (7/14)

- NOAA NOS report declaring ocean aquaculture "can be environmentally sustainable" (1/14)
- OR Chub proposed to be ESA delisted (2/14)
- S.2482 introduced to implement North Pacific High Seas Fisheries Convention (6/14); controversial; version #2 expected this fall
