




High Seas Driftnet Enforcement

Two 2-week deployments by CG HC-130 out of Yokota, JA for MPA support







Suspected HSDN Vessel – FF/V YIN YUAN (CN)







Increased Maritime Operations Northern Sea Route






NORTHWEST PASSAGE (NWP) TRAFFIC










Enhancing Preparedness
