Subject: Pre-Season softshell test

results (Second Round)



In partnership with the Oregon Dungeness Crab Commission, softshell testing was completed at five of six sampling locations off Oregon. The meat recovery criteria to open the fishery on December 1 are 25% or higher south of Cascade Head and 23% or higher north of Cascade Head. All legal-sized male crab caught were included in the sample.

Astoria Nov. 9: 22.3%

(5 of 6 pots at the 45 fm. Station off Seaside were lost)

Garibaldi Due to rough bar conditions, samples could not be collected

from Garibaldi.

Newport Nov. 7: 22.9%

Coos Bay Nov. 9: 23.7%

Port Orford Nov. 9: 17.1%

Brookings Nov. 8: 16.7%

With the low pickout numbers in Port Orford and Brookings, projections show that those areas will not reach the criteria of 25% until well into January. A third round of testing will be conducted in early to mid-December. All other areas are projected to reach their respective criteria on or before Dec. 1. Discussions concerning season openings will be scheduled with other Tri-State representatives as soon as CA and WA report their second round results.
