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2009 Oregon Dungeness Crab Quality Test Results

The second round of preseason Dungeness crab quality testing was conducted in areas that required a follow up test on November 2nd and 3rd. Results indicate that crab from all areas in Oregon now satisfy the meat recovery criteria required in the Tri-State protocols. Crab were also collected for toxin testing and analyzed by the Oregon Department of Agriculture. The results of those tests indicate that the levels of both domoic acid and PST are below any alert levels.
