



## **Sea Safety & Survival Training - Drill Instructor**

Washington Sea Grant is sponsoring a one-day **Sea Safety & Survival Course** (Drill Instructor) for Commercial Fishermen & Charter Boat Operators.

This Coast Guard-approved workshop meets the training requirements of the Commercial Fishing Safety Act to conduct drills. Course work combines lecture and hands on experience with Safety & Survival Equipment now required for commercial fishing vessels. Participants will learn about emergency procedures and will be trained to develop appropriate emergency drills for their own vessels.
