- 1) Will the topographic survey need to include parcel boundaries that may or may not exist within the project vicinity as well as the county road right-of-way near the Hart Diversion site?

Yes, the topographic survey should include parcel boundaries and county road right-of-way.

- 2) What would be the desired date for completion of the basis of design report?

The desired date of completion of the basis of design report has not been determined, but should be included in the work plan schedule.

- 3) Please list the name of all consultants who attended the mandatory field visit?

- 4) Does PSMFC desire CalTrans Standard Specifications, Construction Specification Institute (CSI) format technical specifications, or other?

Either CalTrans or CSI format is acceptable.

- 5) Will PSMFC provide the consultant with front end specifications to accompany the technical specifications, or will the consultant be responsible for preparing front end specifications?

PSMFC will not provide the front end specs. The consultant will be responsible for preparing them.

- 6) Does PSMFC desire a separate design fee for each site, or is one fee for both sites acceptable?

Please prepare one fee for both sites together. If PSMFC desires to hire two consultants, the fee for individual sites can be negotiated at that time. DFG does not anticipate recommending hiring 2 consultants to do the work.

- 7) Does PSMFC desire the final design package (Plans, Specs & Est.) for both sites combined together, or separated for each site?

The design package should be combined together for both sites.
